NJQSAC REVIEW September 2023

Pursuant to the requirements of *N.J.A.C.* 6A:30, the Midland Park School District has undergone the New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC) review. The Bergen County Executive County Superintendent and team conducted a review of the school district's self-assessment on the District Performance Review (DPR) document to verify the school district's compliance with all five areas of NJQSAC. Based on that review, the school district has been placed on a continuum in the five NJQSAC areas: Instruction and Program, Fiscal Management, Governance, Operations and Personnel. As the district has satisfied at least 80% of the weighted indicators in each of the five areas of the NJQSAC review process, Midland Park has been designated as a "high performing" district. The Commissioner of Education will recommend to the State Board of Education that the district be certified as providing a thorough and efficient system of education, for a period of three years or until the next NJQSAC review. The completed NJQSAC county office review resulted in the district receiving the following placement scores for each area listed below:

Instruction and Program: 87% Fiscal Management : 100%

Governance: 93% Operations: 100% Personnel: 100%
